The Italian Social Club Altona was founded on 26th Nov 1976 and incorporated pursuant to the Associations Incorporation Act 1981.

Its predominant aim is to assist the large Italian and Ethnic Community in the Municipality of Altona and surrounding districts by providing social, educational, cultural and recreational activities.

The Club made an initial purchase of Land in Altona in November 1983, however due to objections from adjoining Landowners and Town Planning Appeal Tribunal refusal, a land use permit was not granted.

On 18th. April 1986 the Club obtained Leasehold Land in Kyle Rd., North Altona from the Dept. of Conservation, Forests and Lands.

Delays occurred in obtaining a land use permit due to objections from neighbouring landowners who appealed to the Town Planning Tribunal.

On 15th January 1987, the Club was granted a building permit conditional on design modifications.

On 4th May 1988 the building permit was issued.

In August 1988 construction of the Clubrooms commenced. The building project was financed from Members funds generated from subscriptions, fundraising activities and from Grants obtained from various Federal, State and Local Government Departments.

The Building Committee also entered into negotiations with the Commonwealth Bank whereby the Club has borrowed the extra funds required to finalise the project.

Six years later on 2nd July 1994, the Clubrooms are officially opened by The Hon. Ralph Willis M.P, Federal Treasurer and its doors are open to all its members.

The Club is now committed in providing a social centre for the community who share a common pursuit of friendship and exchange of Italian experience and culture.

The Club desires to cultivate and pass on to future generations the industrious spirit of the Italian people for the ultimate benefit of all Australians.
